



Lord Deramore's Out of School Club

Lord Deramore's Out of School Club is a registered charity set up over 20 years ago to provide before-school and after-school childcare for children who attend Lord Deramore's Primary School. Located in the grounds of the school, children are cared for at the Club by a team of trained, qualified staff. The Club Co-ordinator is Adele Ross who holds an NVQ3 level qualification in play work, an NVQ3 level qualification in children's care, learning and development, Adele is also an accredited Senco; the Deputy Co-ordinator is Debbie Walton. All staff are certified First Aiders.

Opening times

The Club opens Monday to Friday term time only and children are able to attend for a variety of sessions as required.

Session times are:

Breakfast club 8am – start of school

After school club 3.15pm – 5.45pm

Fees

As a registered charity, the Club does not aim to make a profit from the fees charged to attend sessions; the money raised is used to cover running costs, such as staff salaries, bills, rent, new equipment, art materials etc. Currently, the fees stand at:

Breakfast club £3.20 per child, per session

After school club £7.25 per child, per session

Age groups

The Club is registered on the Early Years Register and the compulsory and voluntary parts of the Childcare Register. The setting also offers care to children in Years 1-6, with the older children (over eight years old) being cared for in a separate room. The setting supports children whose first language is not English.

Activities

There is a range of resources for children to choose from including many varied art and craft activities for children to explore and make models to take home. Children are able to choose what they would like to play with and can access resources for themselves such as construction toys, books and role-play, as well as enjoy some "chill-out time" if they prefer.



There is a dedicated garden area for outdoor play which is within the school grounds.



Appropriate healthy snacks and drinks are offered at both the breakfast and after school sessions.

Policies and regulations

The Club is subject to Ofsted inspections and achieved a “Good” overall level at the most recent inspection (November 2011). A copy of the inspector’s report may be found on the Ofsted website: <http://www.ofsted.gov.uk/>

Appropriate regulations and policies regarding childcare and charity work are in place and are reviewed regularly. These have been drawn up in conjunction with York Council, as well as the Charity Commission.
