## Academy Conversion and the formation of the South York Multi-Academy Trust

I write to update you on our plans for our academy conversion and to establish the South York Multi-Academy Trust.

Lord Deramore's Primary and most of our intended partner schools have now received their academy orders and thus are able to begin the conversion process. The timing and the phasing of this conversion process will, however, be substantially different to the details originally given. This is linked to the City of York Council's scheduling of the conversion process and the time required to complete the conversion work. Because of this, Lord Deramore's Primary is currently planned to complete its academy conversion by 1st November 2018 with the other partner schools currently granted academy orders joining on the planned dates indicated below. Given Escrick School is part of North Yorkshire County Council, a separate date for Escrick joining the South York Multi-Academy Trust will be agreed. As you will see from the indicative dates below, the establishment and development of the MAT will now take place with schools joining on an individual basis and over a longer period of time than was originally planned. This is not an issue in terms of the development of the Multi-Academy Trust or for the conversion of Lord Deramore's Primary given we have always stated the importance of ensuring the conversion happens in the right way rather than at any specific set time.
