Literacy	<p>Most of our literacy is taught through stories. This term, our books will reflect our topic and be about transport or journeys. We will write a mixture of fiction and non-fiction and cover these grammar elements: Capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks Commas in a list Commas between clauses Conjunctions to link ideas (and, but, so, when, if, because) Prefixes and suffixes Noun phrases (description) Apostrophes</p>
History	<p>We will be studying the history of transport and how and why it has changed over time (both within and beyond living memory). This will include learning about significant people in the history of transport such as George Stephenson. We will develop an understanding of chronology and identify similarities and differences between ways of life in different periods.</p>

Science	We will be finding out about the properties of different materials such as wood, plastic, glass, metal etc. and conducting investigations to find out how they are affected by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.
Computing	We will be using code to design games which use different inputs.
DT	We will be looking at, designing, making and evaluating moving vehicles with axles.
Art	We will be exploring prints and then making and evaluating our own prints using toy vehicles.
