Curriculum Overview for Year 2
Spring Term – Great Fire of London



Mathematics	<p>Multiplication and division (grouping and sharing) 2, 5 and 10 x tables Odd and even numbers Adding and subtracting 2 two-digit numbers (eg. 25 + 37, 48 – 26) 2D and 3D shapes Telling the time Recognising common fractions Finding fractions of a shape or amount</p>
Literacy	<p>Most of our literacy is taught through stories. This term, some of our books will reflect our topic, for example 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London'. We will write a mixture of fiction and non-fiction and cover these grammar elements: Capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks Commas in a list Commas between clauses Conjunctions to link ideas (and, but, so, when, if, because) Prefixes and suffixes Noun phrases (description) Apostrophes</p>
History	<p>We will be studying the period of history in which the Great Fire of London happened, including elements such as daily life, buildings and the development of the fire service. In geography, we will look at the location of London and the other capitals of countries within the United Kingdom, as well as using maps and plans.</p>

RE	<p>In RE, we will be looking at how different religions celebrate special times.</p>
Science	<p>We will be finding out about the properties of different materials such as wood, plastic, glass, metal etc. and conducting investigations to find out how they are affected by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.</p>
Computing	<p>We will be using code to design games which use different inputs.</p>
DT	<p>We will be tasting, designing and then baking our own bread.</p>
Art	<p>Different painting techniques will be used to create a frieze based on the Great Fire of London.</p>
Music	<p>Mrs Martin will continue to develop the children's general music skills as well as their ocarina skills. The children will learn to play 'London's Burning' in a round.</p>
PE	<p>We will be developing our dance skills as well as working with PE specialist Liam Holmes for basketball.</p>
