Curriculum Overview for Year 3  
Spring Term – Tudors and Stuarts



Mathematics	Multiplication and division 4, 6, 8 x tables Measurement: money, length and perimeter Statistics Fractions
English	Much of our literacy is taught through stories. This term, we will focus on the author Anthony Browne and some of our books will reflect our topic, for example 'Vlad and the Great Fire of London'. We will write a mixture of fiction and non-fiction and cover these grammar elements: Fronted adverbials Subordinating conjunctions (for example: although, as, when, while) Writing in paragraphs We will also recap and develop skills taught in Autumn term such as use of speech punctuation and noun phrases (description).
History	We will be focus on the Tudors and Stuarts including elements such as daily life, buildings and the development of the fire service.
Geography	In geography, we will look at the location of London and the other capitals of countries within Europe, as well as using maps and plans.
RE	In RE, we will be looking at how and why different religions pray.
Science	We will describe and sort rocks into groups, including the 3 main rock types. We will conduct simple investigations with rocks, learn how fossils are formed and find out about Mary Anning, the famous fossil hunter. In the second half term, we will learn about our bodies with a focus on muscles, bones and healthy eating.
Computing	We will be using code to design games which use different inputs.
DT	We will taste and bake bread linked to the Great Fire of London. We will practise chopping and grating techniques and design and make our own sandwiches (using our own bread) to link with our Science work.
Art	We will find out about Tudor artwork and create our own portraits. Different painting techniques will be used to create pictures based on the Great Fire of London.
Music	Mrs Martin will continue to develop the children's general music skills as well as their recorder skills. The children will learn to play 'London's Burning' in a round.
PE	Year 3 will be working with the York City Knights to develop their rugby skills after half term. They will also be focusing on Tudor dancing and various gymnastics and games skills.
