- We will not let a child leave the premises with another adult unless we have your written permission

Transition into School

We have been in contact with the pre-schools and nurseries to arrange reports to be sent to school and telephone conversations about each child.

Provisional Managed Start – timings to be confirmed

- Hour long stay and play sessions in small groups with a chance to talk to staff
- Hour long sessions to visit without parents in small groups
- Part time sessions either a morning or an afternoon in groups of 15 (hopefully one day will include a chance to stay for lunch)
- Stay at school full time (NB the timings of the day may be shorter than usual due to restrictions during the Coronavirus outbreak)

- Be positive
- Pass on information to school that may affect your child or helps us understand them
- Read stories, sing songs and talk!
- Be prepared have everything ready and show your child what they will need
