We always look forward to the summer term and have planned lots of interesting and exciting activities for the children. In every subject we will be identifying gaps brought about by interrupted schooling, and aiming to ensure that no child misses a key part of their school education. We will continue to support children who require a bit of extra help, and extend the learning of those who need it, just as we have always done.

We wish to thank all of you for helping to keep the children organised with their belongings, reading regularly and arriving at school on time. These things make such a difference to the children feeling happy and settled in school, and show we are all working together to help all our children be 'the best that they can be'.

Homework

A new homework menu will be emailed out via ParentPay and will also be stuck in your child's homework book. The homework menu reflects the work we are doing in school and is designed to:

- provide an opportunity for parents to talk about school activities with their child
- practise and develop skills
- spark curiosity or interest in a child about an aspect of their learning
- encourage good homework habits in preparation for older year groups

We encourage all children to complete an item from the menu each week. Parents and carers can help and support as you feel appropriate. Please come and talk to us if you have any concerns regarding homework.



Year 2:

Homework books: Home every Thursday and return to school every Tuesday. Spelling folders: Home every Monday and return to school every Friday.

Year 3:

Homework books: Home every Friday and return to school every Wednesday. Spelling books: Home every Friday and return to school every Thursday.

Year 2 have access to NumBots to practise number facts, and Year 3 children have online access to TTRockstars and Sumdog. The children's passwords are in their planners.

Reading

Please read regularly with your child. No amount of reading in school can surpass the positive influence of a parent. If your child is reluctant, you could start off by reading the book to them and chatting to them about the story. Another time, you could read a sentence and then the child reads it back to you, or you could read alternate sentences / words. A reading routine often works well or a reward system — "After we have read, you can....."



Children on book boxes continue to need support reading fluently for meaning. Children who are independent readers need support choosing appropriate books for their ability and developing the key skills of inference and deduction (i.e. reading between the lines). Ideally, we would like all children to read at home most days. Please write the title of your child's book and tick in the planner when your child has read at home, either with you or independently, and tick 'Please change' when they are ready for a new book. Children can change books any day of the week.

As well as a reading book, all children have free choice of a book from the school library. Year 2 will swap library books on a **Wednesday** and Year 3 will change books on a rota.

Lost Property

Every term we have an enormous amount of unnamed lost property. This is sorted through regularly and clothes which are named are handed back to their owners. Please check that **ALL** of your child's clothes / shoes / PE kit / bags/water bottles etc. are named. Trainers and wellies need to be in a **named** plastic bag.

Forest Schools

Starting this week, Year 2 will have Forest School on a Monday and Year 3 on a Tuesday. Please can all children have their kit in school each week. We will go into the forest whatever the weather so they do need clothes that will keep them warm and dry.
