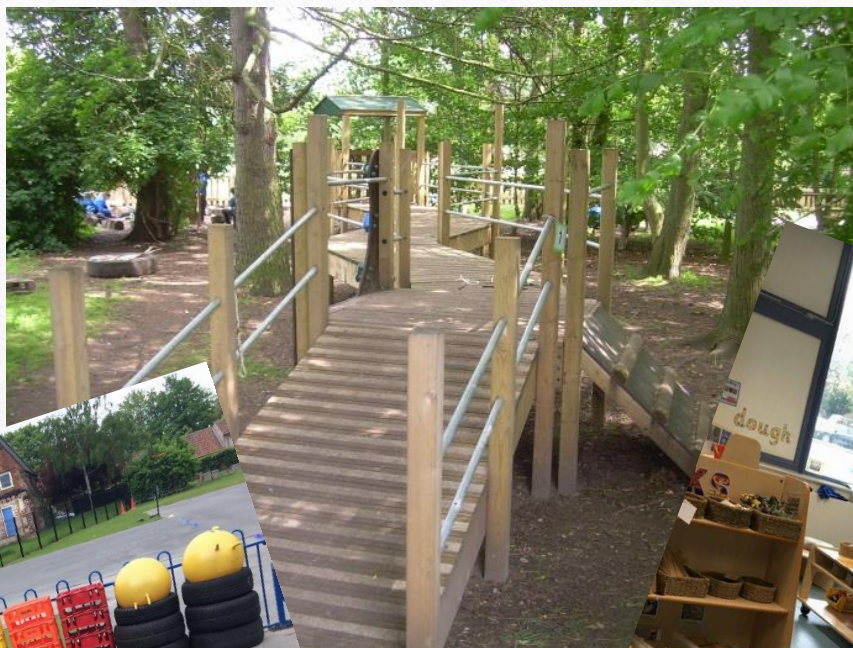

Snacks and Milk

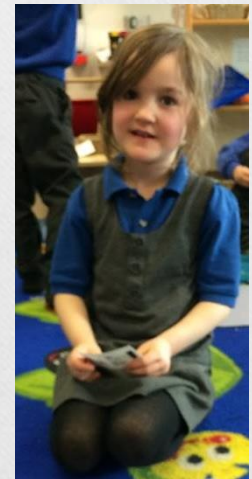
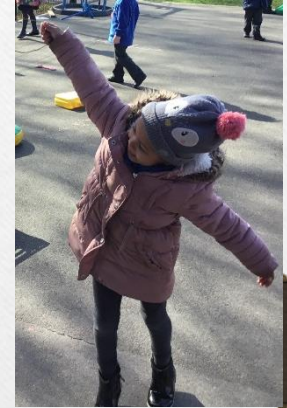
- ❖ Fruit – available all day

- ❖ We will not let a child leave the premises with another adult unless we have your written permission

Transition into School

❖ **Starting School in September**

- Tuesday 7th September – stay and play sessions throughout the day
- Wednesday 8th and Thursday 9th September - part time 8.50-11.45am
- Friday 10th September - 8.50-12.15pm - You will be able to join your child for a trial lunch at **11.15am**. Your child's lunch will be free, the adult lunch will be £3.

******There will be a chance to have a meeting with Mr Sharpe for ten minutes one of the afternoons – sign up at your visit

- From Monday 13th September – full time 8.50am-3.15pm

How You Can Help at Home
