Curriculum Overview Year 1 and 2 Autumn Term 2017

Topic	Weather
Maths	Will be taught in accordance with the National Curriculum and this term will include: Number and place value Addition and subtraction Multiplication and division Fractions Measurement Geometry
English	Will be taught in accordance with the National Curriculum and this term will include: Year 1 Stories with a familiar setting Instructions Poetry on a theme Stories with repeating patterns Year 2 Recounts Stories Poetry Instructions
Science	Year 1 the children will: Identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees. Year 2 the children will: Describe basic needs of plants for survival & impact of changing these Describe main changes as seeds & bulbs grow into plants Identify whether things are alive, dead or have never lived Work scientifically <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • asking simple questions and recognising that they can be answered in different ways • observing closely, using simple equipment • performing simple tests • identifying and classifying • using their observations and ideas to suggest answers to questions
History	
Geography	The children will: Name, locate and identify characteristics of the 4 countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas Use world maps, atlases and globes to identify the United Kingdom and its countries, as well as the countries, continents and oceans Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the United Kingdom and the location of hot and cold areas of the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles Use aerial photographs and plan perspectives to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features; devise a simple map; and use and construct basic symbols in a key
Computing	The children will: Learn what algorithms are; how they are implemented as programs on digital devices; and that programs execute by following precise and unambiguous instructions. They will create and debug their own simple programs
R.E	Year 1 'Who is a Christian and what do they believe?' Year 2 'Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?'
P.E	Year 1 and 2 will be participating in games, gymnastics and dance
Art	Year 1 and Year 2 will be introduced to famous artists and works of art; they will make their own versions of art using different techniques including: brushstrokes, texture, colour, line, pattern and shape
Music	The children will be focussing on singing. They will be using instruments and symbols to focus on pulse and rhythm. They will be preparing for their Christmas performance
