Summer Term 'Houses and Homes

Numeracy	<p>Will be taught in accordance with the National Curriculum and will include:</p> <p>Year 1: Halves and quarters of shapes and quantities Numbers and place value to 100 Number bonds to 10 and 20 Using knowledge of number bonds to add and subtract</p> <p>Year 2: Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division within word problems Data handling Naming and sorting 2D and 3D shapes</p>
English	<p>Will be taught in accordance with the National Curriculum and will include:</p> <p>Year 1 and Year 2:</p> <p>Writing stories with a fantasy setting Poetry based on a theme Non fiction</p>
Science	<p>We will be exploring and observing seasonal change in the local environment. Year 1 will study animals in the local environment and in contrasting environments around the world. We will also explore the five senses (touch, taste, smell, sight, and hearing).</p> <p>Year 2 will be studying animals in their habitats, lifecycles and food chains.</p>
History	<p>We will be finding out about a significant event in history beyond living memory - The Great Fire of London.</p>
Geography	<p>We will be learning to name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans</p>
RE	<p>Year 1 will be focusing on what it means to belong to a faith community.</p> <p>Year 2 will develop and explore the topic 'How should we care for others and the world, and why does it matter?'</p>
PE	<p>Year 1 and 2 will be developing skills such as athletics and learning to play team games.</p>
Art/DT	<p>We will be painting, designing and creating sculptures.</p>
Computing	<p>We will be learning to use computer coding and learning how to use technology safely and respectfully, keeping personal information private identify where to go for help and support when they have concerns about content or contact on the internet or other online technologies.</p>
