- Visit 3 (groups of 15): Wednesday 20th July –
 9.30-11.30am or 1-3pm
- Visit 4 (groups of 15): Thursday 21st July 9.30-11.30am or 1-3pm

Transition into School

Starting School in September

- Tuesday 6th, Wednesday 7th, Thursday 8th September - 8:40-11:45am all in school, with parent meetings in the afternoon (choose all available slots on Google Form)
- Friday 9th September 8:40am-11:30am stay in school for lunch (11:30am-12pm) with one parent (if you're available) fill in Google Form
- Full time from Monday 12th September
 8:40am-3:15pm

How You Can Help at Home

- Encourage independence dressing and undressing, toileting, tidying up, asking for help.
- Be positive.
- Pass on information to school that may affect your child or helps us understand them.
- Read stories, sing songs and talk!
- Be prepared have everything ready and show your child what they will need and get them to help you pack their things (so they know what's theirs).
- Send Book Bags everyday, send children in forest school kit on forest school days, keep PE kits in school, have a full change of clothing incase of accidents.
