The 7 continents are: North America, South America, Europe, Africa, Asia, Oceania and Antarctica.

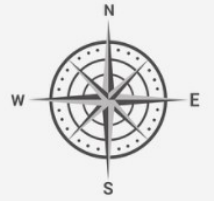


The 5 oceans are: the Pacific Ocean, the Atlantic Ocean, the Arctic Ocean, the Indian Ocean and the Southern Ocean.

Recent	In the past but not a long time ago.
Significant	Important and worth knowing about.
Voyage	A long journey, especially by ship or into space.

Explorers travel to unfamiliar places

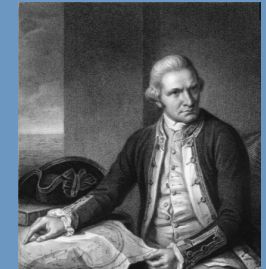
Ibn Battuta

Ibn Battuta was born in 1304. He spent nearly 30 years travelling. In 1354, he told a writer about his explorations. These were written up in a book called the Rihla.



James Cook

Captain James Cook sailed to New Zealand and landed in Australia in 1770. Cook travelled around the world twice in his life.



Neil Armstrong

In 1969, Armstrong was the first human to step on the Moon. Buzz Aldrin walked on the moon with him and Michael Collins stayed in the main craft.



Mae Jemison

Astronaut, doctor and engineer, Mae Jemison was the first Black woman to go into space in 1992. She was one of seven astronauts aboard the Space Shuttle Endeavour.
