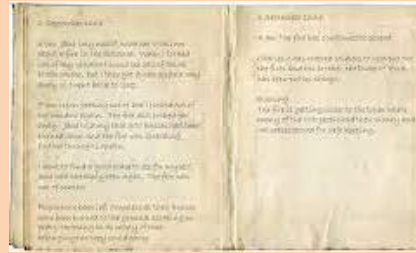
Be an architect

Design a poster warning people of the dangers of fire and how to use it safely.



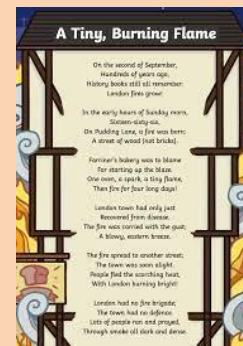
Be a scientist

Research and record information about Mary Anning, a famous archaeologist who made some important findings about rocks.



Be a poet

Be a researcher

Use the internet or books to find out more about the Great Fire of Edinburgh 1824. Make a table to record similarities and differences between this fire and the Great Fire of London



Be a quizzer

Write your own questions answers for a quiz about the Great fire of London. Perhaps you could test them on your adults at home or friends in your class.



Be a baker

Find and follow a simple recipe to make your own bread. Be careful- don't start any fires!
