<p>Be a scientist Create your own magnetic vehical. Tape a magnet on a toy and pull it along using another magnet. Which poles attract? Which poles repel? (If you do not have access to a magnet please get in touch and we can provide one).</p> 	<p>Be active Create your own obstacle course. What could you use? How fast can you complete it? Can you get a member of your family complete it?</p> 	<p>Be an artist Draw an aerial perspective of your house. Walk around your house and draw the first floor. What details can you add in?
