







## Year 3 Homework Menu – January/February 2025 (Explorers)

We would love to see anything your child produces or hear how they have got on. Please complete an activity as and when you have the time but you do not need to complete them all. Share what you have done with your class by bringing your work in, emailing your teacher or sending in a USB stick. We love to see writing, books, videos, pictures, models and more!

<p><b>Be a Mathematician</b> Learn the 3 and 4 times tables off by heart. *Practise counting aloud or alternately with an adult/sibling. *Practise the tables in order and then random order. *Find objects in your house in 3s or 4s (e.g. spots on Lego pieces, wheels on toy cars) and use these to practise multiplying and dividing e.g. there are 20 wheels altogether, how many cars are there? <b>If you are confident, do the same with 8s and 6s.</b></p>	<p><b>Be an Explorer (Geography)</b> Stand in your garden or another open space. Use a compass (or a compass app) to find out which way is north, south, east and west. Once you know the 4 main points, tell an adult where the following points are: north east, south, east, south west, north west.</p> 	<p><b>Be a designer</b></p>  <p>Design an outfit for an explorer. Firstly decide <b>where</b> they will explore e.g. jungle, desert, space, underwater. What will they wear? What equipment will they need? Add labels to your design.</p>	<p><b>Be a reader</b></p>  <p><b>Show what you know</b> about a character from a book you are reading/have read recently. It could be a character from a fiction book or a real person from a non-fiction book. How would you describe them? What do they like and dislike? You could write about them, draw them, make a model or write a poem about them.</p>
<p><b>Be Cultured</b></p>  <p>Lunar new year celebrations will take place at the end of January. Find out what happens in a country that celebrates.</p>	<p><b>Be a Scientist</b> Go on a rock scavenger hunt at the beach or where you live. Can you find: a <b>smooth</b> rock, a <b>rough</b> rock, a rock with <b>lines</b> in it, a rock with <b>holes</b> in it, a rock that's <b>flat on one side</b>, a <b>heart-shaped</b> rock, a rock with <b>2 colours</b>, a rock <b>smaller than your little finger nail</b>, a rock with <b>something growing on it</b> and a rock <b>you like</b>. Can you sort your rock collection into groups? Happy hunting!</p>		<p><b>Be an Explorer (Geography)</b></p>  <p>Imagine you have discovered a new island. Draw a map of what you have found. Give your island a name. Which ocean/sea is it surrounded by?</p>
