LEAVE OF ABSENCE – Very important please read

If you plan to take your child out of school during term time, the <u>Leave of Absence form</u> **must** be completed and returned to the school office. Leave of absence cannot be granted due to parental work commitments. The University of York and Ministry of Defence fully supports the need for children to be in school during term time. Owing to our long waiting lists for places, unauthorised absences or international travel of more than 2 weeks could result in your child being removed from our school's register. You would then need to re-apply for a place on your return to York/UK.

IMPORTANT: If your child has <u>5</u> or more days of unauthorised absence throughout any given academic year, parents and carers will <u>automatically</u> receive a fixed-term penalty notice - issued by the local authority. Our school no longer has flexibility in not issuing these. Therefore, <u>please</u> ensure that you do not book family holidays during school term dates as penalty notices are now issued across all schools in York.
