In English we have read some books by Sam Usher. Write your own story about Sam and Grandad.



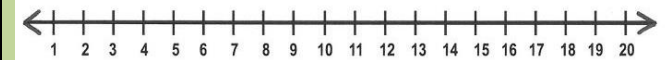
What type of weather will be in your story? What adventure might they go on?
