English

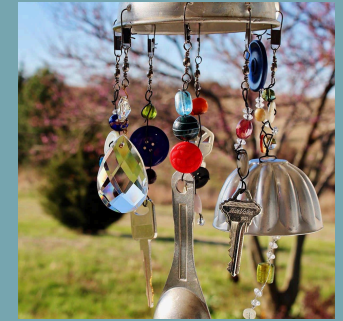
History

Music

Maths

Use tally marks to record how often you see sun, rain or clouds for a week.



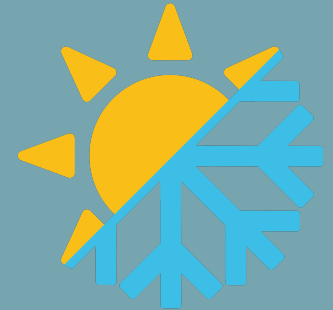
Reading

Science
