Be an investigator

Be an Artist

Create a piece of fire artwork using things you have at home e.g. pens, paints, collage. It could be a fireplace, an outdoor fire or a candle.



Wild Card!

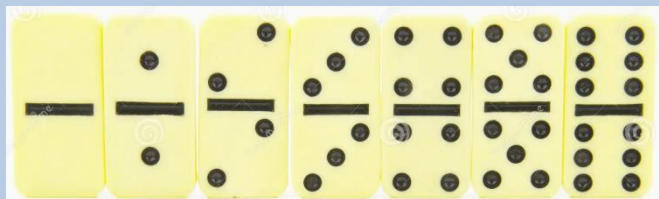


Learn a new skill! It can be anything at all but here are some ideas: learn to tie a knot, learn to tell the time on an analogue clock, learn to wrap a present...

Be a Mathematician

*Do you know all your doubles up to 10+10? Ask an adult to help you practise. Can you use your toys (e.g. Lego bricks) to show that you know the answers?

*If you are confident with doubles to 10, how far can you double?
E.g. 2, 4, 8, 16.../3, 6, 12, 24...and so on.



Be a Reader

Look at a non-fiction book from home or the library. Ask an adult to challenge you to find particular information using the contents and index pages. Write down 3 facts you have learnt from reading your book.



Be a Scientist

Make a list of as many different materials you can find in your house as you can. Can you find some more unusual materials?
