Be a scientist Can you start your own rock collection from rocks you find in your garden or out and about. What do you notice about them? Are there similarities and differences between them? Can you sort them into groups? Which groups will you choose? 	Be an artist Create a piece of artwork inspired by the Great Fire of London. Use materials you already have at home: paint, crayon, collage. 	Be a quizzer Write a quiz about the Great Fire of London and ask someone at home your questions. Make sure you know the answers so you can tell them if they were right or wrong! Can you set a challenge question too?
