Talk about places that you have visited as a family. If you have photographs, look at them and see how much you can remember from your visit.



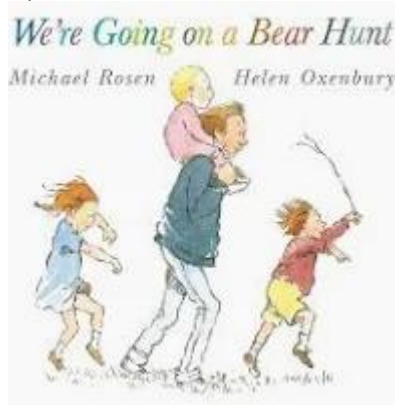
Play vehicle bingo - how many different types of transport you can spot. Can you spot things that travel on land, water and the air?
